Introduction

On March 22, 2016, Community Development Staff Training College officially received the books from Books2Africa through the Minister in charge of the ministry. The Ceremony was held at the ministry headquarters in Lusaka. (Refer to the photos).

Logistics

The books were then transported to the college in Kitwe, about 360 kilometres north of the capital Lusaka. They were then offloaded and listed, accordingly (refer to the list of books). The total number of books was 1091. There were also 13 folders in one box.

This has been necessitated by the fact that most of the books we received are suitable for the high school grades and below, contrary to what we requested for; social sciences and related books for our college. We have however stocked them in the Community Development library, accordingly and we will continue to sensitise more high schoolers on the availability of the books in the college library given that most of them are useful at their level. Just a few are suitable for our students (Those on computer, business and food).
