With these books the college library shall act as a model library for medical institutions and the community by providing the required information in abundance



We had issues with the packing list which was not specific and it delayed the clearing process at the port, I would highly advise that you consider detailed packing list that specifies item per item.

There was also an error on the detailed packing list that you sent us, it showed 500 computers and yet there were 20 laptops and 10 desktops. This also affected us during the final clearing/verification by the revenue officers

We are also having issues with the computers and the laptops that you sent us. Some are not working at all, and others are having serious issues regarding their functioning. I thought Grade A computers and laptops would be in good condition, but these ones are not good to be honest.

We also had issues with clearing our shipment in Uganda because of the used computers and laptops. Our country no longer allows used computers in the country. We went through a lot to get cleared finally.

Some books are also too old and in bad physical condition. I would suggest that you consider books that are current, and are in good condition.

Otherwise, we are very grateful with the offer and belief that our library is not the same. We hope to share photos and video of our library when we have finished sorting, processing and arranging the books on the shelves. Thank you so much.
