Most of the children are from the street, who are involved in commercial sex or domestic work, who are being trafficked, who are involved in drugs abuse, Orphans, Marginalized and poor children. help them to get formal and Non formal education right from Nursery to Secondary level and Vocational training education as well as colleges when there is availability of funds.

Watoto Wetu Tanzania received 500 educational books from African Aid Foundation/Books2Africa, which have had a meaningful and transformative impact on the children and youth they support. These books have:
