What makes us different is that we provide reading, research and a library for the disabled, which is the only school of such in Jos.

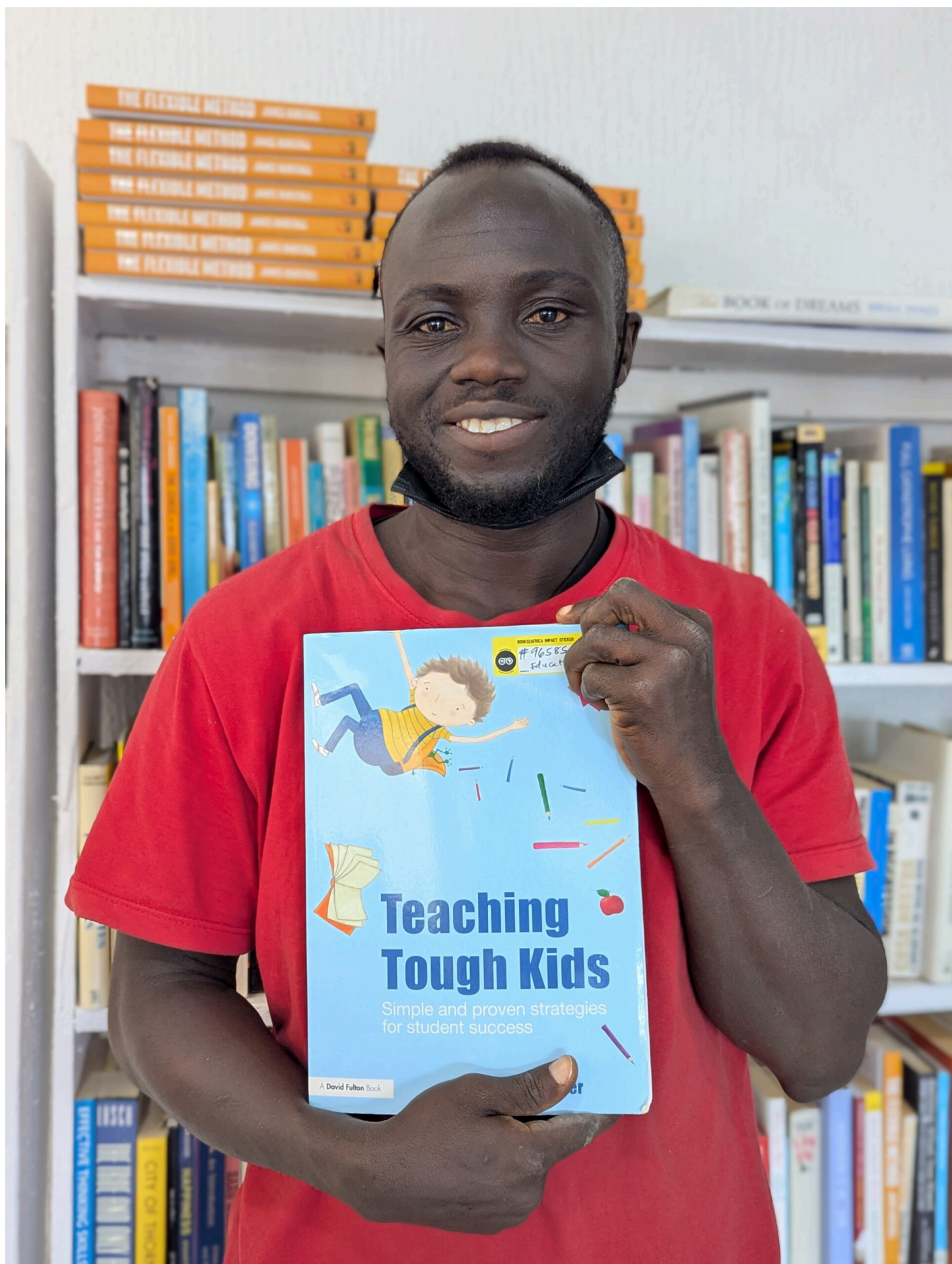
